BY-LAW 32 OF 2017

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF ST. MARYS

Being a By-law to authorize the use of optical scanning vote tabulators and vote recorders for the purpose of counting votes at the 2018 municipal election.

WHEREAS: Section 42 of the Municipal Elections Act, 1996, S.O. 1996. c.32

provides that the Council of a municipality may, by by-law, authorize

the use of voting and vote-counting equipment such as voting

machines, voting recorders or optical scanning vote tabulators for the

purpose of counting votes at Municipal Elections;

AND WHEREAS: The Council of the Town of St. Marys deems it appropriate and in the

public interest to pass such a by-law;

NOW THEREFORE: The Council of The Corporation of the Town of St. Marys hereby enacts

as follows;

1. The use of optical scanning vote tabulators and vote recorders for

the purpose of counting votes at a municipal election

2. That the Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to secure an agreement with an appropriate service provider for the provision

of optical scanning vote tabulators and vote recorder equipment.

3. This By-Law comes into force and takes effect on the final passing

thereof.
