**Petition to Protect the Grand Trunk trail from the extension of Wellington Street North**

Please ensure that this petition is seen by Mayor Strathdee and the town council. It will be presented formally to council on Tuesday June 27<sup>th</sup>. This package contains:

1. The petition letter outlining my own and the signatories' concerns with the current Official Plan to extend Wellington Street North in such a way that the Grand Trunk trail is bisected. The petition letter is marked with red for ease of identification.
2. Next, you will find a separate collection of comments from the petition signers. These are individuals who felt that it was important that the mayor and council understand their individual reasons for opposing the extension of Wellington Street. You will see some signatures and comments from out of town; many of these are either former residents of St. Marys, or local people who visit St. Marys to use the trails.
3. The last section contains the signatures themselves. There are pen and paper signatures and printed copies of the electronic signatures. There are some duplicates where an individual has signed both the paper and the electronic petition; these duplicates have been removed from the final tally count.

**Six hundred and seventy-six (676) individuals oppose the extension of Wellington Street into the Grand Trunk Trail.**

Recognizing that the mayor and council may be most interested in the opinions of those who are eligible to vote in municipal elections, a separate tally of adults living in St. Marys (and excluding nearby towns) who have signed the petition is included: there are five hundred and forty-two (542) of these.

In addition, forty-one (41) of our signatories are youth in the town of St. Mary's. Jakob Krausz, who attends Holy Name of Mary School, feels strongly about this issue and worked hard to reach out to other young individuals about how they would be affected by damage to the trail they use most days of the week. He will be presenting this petition to council on June 27<sup>th</sup>. Thank you very much for your attention to this important issue!

Greetings,

St. Marys is rightfully proud of our walking trails and beautiful green spaces. We're also a growing community building new places for families to live in. The Town of St. Marys Official Plan currently calls for Wellington Street to be extended north to service new housing developments north of the Grand Trunk trail. This is a mistake.

An extension of Wellington Street North will:


1. Cut the Grand Trunk Trail in half and put pedestrian and cyclist safety at risk.
2. Flatten more than thirty mature trees, similar to the devastation that can be seen from the Grand Trunk Trail at Emily Street.
3. Destroy the pond and streams that run alongside the Grand Trunk Trail.
4. Cause serious traffic congestion and risks to pedestrian safety along Wellington Street in the downtown core.

Let's encourage St. Marys Town Council to keep new housing developments connected using existing roads and new walking trails, rather than carving a channel for heavy traffic through the middle of town.

This is only one of many beautiful places in St. Marys that are threatened by hasty development plans. We want town council to consider all its options when making choices that impact St. Mary's natural heritage. We need more parks, more trails, more trees, and municipal policies that will protect them for the future.

It is so hard to believe that there is and has never been any "tree cutting" by-law on the town's law books to even begin to protect any of our resources like trees, especially the ones on "private" land. <del>Town council might as well put notices beside all the roads leading into St. Marys saying that land owners and the developers they hire can pretty well do what they want, where they want.</del> I know the money from increased property taxes as a result of unimpeded development in St. Marys is a tempting way to justify the current policy, but the price of less tree shade, fewer homes for wildlife, less oxygen produced at the detriment of our breathing air and less natural walking space for town citizens is simply too high to continue this "free for all" policy concerning clear-cutting and other damage to the town's natural resources. Protective by-laws in St. Marys must be put in place at once. I feel that some referendums should be held in order to give concerned St. Marys people a voice in deciding what development can be permitted and what can't. I believe conservation issues are too important and life-changing for the present and future populations of St. Marys to be placed solely in the hands of a few people, even if they were elected to run the town. I consider Trout Creek, the Thames River, the walking trails foliage and trees in the area part of my shared heritage in St. Marys, and I am not willing to sell it away recklessly for a property owner's financial gain or for the convenience of a developer. I think many others in town don't want that either. I also don't want to be left with a bunch of saplings that will take 50 years or more to grow either. How do we find shade from the worsening summer heat, etc. in the meantime? Other communities are watching what St. Marys does now, and I feel the town is definitely sending out the wrong message and heading down the wrong path in its actions and lack of protective natural resource legislation. Between Ardmore Park and Emily Street, there has already been too much development damage. A rational compromise between "healthy" development and protecting our town natural heritage has to be reached as soon as possible, hopefully with the town population's real input, rather than public statements issued like "we will relocate wildlife left homeless after trees are cut down." Give us a break - if wildlife are in trees that are being cut down (baby birds, baby raccoons), this wildlife is dead as soon as the trees hit the ground. We all are left with the consequences if no changes are made in town policy. I'd like to tell children in St. Marys 20 years down the way, "St. Marys was losing its trees and natural living space, but we turned things around, and found a healthy balance between development for homes, senior centres, etc. and still having enough trees, walking and bicycling trails to really make St. Marys "a town worth living in". It's too late for Emily Street and Ardmore Park - we'll never get those trees back, all we have left are photos of the beauty that was there. Environmental compromise takes work and the courage to forge a better path. Let's try to save what's left for the town's kids, grandkids and all those folks that will be here 100 years from now.</p>
