

## **BY-LAW 51 OF 2017**

### **THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF ST. MARYS**

Being a By-law to authorize the signing of an agreement between The Corporation of the Town of St. Marys and Province of Ontario through the Ministry of Transportation.

**WHEREAS:** The Province of Ontario had implemented the Public Transit Infrastructure Fund for the purpose of funding transit infrastructure projects undertaken by Ontario municipalities and local boards; and,

**WHEREAS:** The Corporation of the Town of St. Marys is responsible for building and maintaining sidewalks within its jurisdiction, and has prepared a capital program for 2017 to improve the accessibility and interconnectedness of the Town's sidewalk network; and,

**WHEREAS:** The Corporation of the Town of St. Marys deems it expedient to enter into an Agreement with the Province of Ontario who shall be responsible for contributing \$67,000 to the Town of St. Marys for the purpose of improving the accessibility and interconnectedness of the Town's sidewalk network.

**NOW THEREFORE:** The Council of the Corporation of the Town of St. Marys hereby enacts as follows;

1. That the Mayor and the Clerk are authorized to execute an Agreement on behalf of the Corporation of the Town of St. Marys between the Corporation of the Town of St. Marys and the Province of Ontario through the Ministry of Transportation; and further
2. That a copy of the said Agreement is attached hereto and designated as Schedule "A" to this By-law, and to affix thereto the corporate seal of the Corporation of the Town of St. Marys.
3. This By-Law comes into force and takes effect on the final passing thereof.

Read a first and second time this 13<sup>th</sup> day of June, 2017.

Read a third and final time and passed this 13<sup>th</sup> day of June, 2017.
